SPARKLING WINE

NV Ferrari Maximum Brut	125ml £9.50	Bottle £55
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Trento, Italy

A deep straw yellow with a gentle, yet positive and persistent bouquet, with a note of ripe fruit accompanied by hints of crusty bread, hazelnuts and variegated floral aromas. Dry, elegant and well-balanced.

NV Louis Pommery Bru		£55
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Hampshire, England

A pale yellow robe. Effervescent giving the impression of a cloud, veil of bubbles. On the nose, aromas of tangy red fruits, gooseberry with hints of citrus and a spicy finish. On the palate, aromas of red fruits with a well-balanced, pure and fresh finish.

CHAMPAGNE

NV Pommery Brut Royal	125ml £11	Bottle £64
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Champagne, France

The colour is pale yellow with faint green highlights. This is lively, fresh and vivacious, fine, delicate and generous. Citrus fruit and white flower notes combine with small red fruits to offer elegance balanced with great finesse and complex finish.

NV Taittinger Brut Reserve		£78
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Champagne, France

From Champagne's oldest cellars, this Champagne has peach and acacia notes on the nose, a citrus-fresh yet delicately honeyed palate, and a beautiful, elegant finish. Taittinger is one of the last great Champagne Houses to remain independent and is owned and actively managed by the family named on the label.

NV Pommery Blanc de Blancs		£88
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Champagne, France

Made from 100% Chardonnay for a light, fresh champagne ideal for drinking on long, warm sunny days or simply as a reminder of the summer. Look for the light golden colour tinged with green and indulge in aromas of hay and freshly cut grass.

NV Ruinart Blanc de Blancs		£125
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Champagne, France

Beautiful pale golden yellow colour with gentle green reflections, a vibrant, luminous colour. Active effervescence with a persistent release of bubbles. At first very intense on the nose, with fresh fruit notes, particularly ripe citrus fruits. A second refined floral nose with notes of white flowers and fruits (white peaches, pineapple). A supple, harmonious attack on the palate, very rounded. Vinosity that is not excessive, supported by excellent freshness. Notes of nectarines, citrus fruits with a pleasant mineral quality in the finish. Long, very refreshing finish.

CHAMPAGNE

2007 Bollinger Grande Année 125ml Bottle

Champagne, France

There is an abundance of ripe and generous flavour on the nose, with quince, caramelised apple and hazelnut standing out. The palate is broad, with a creamy texture from the oak fermentation and fine, delicate mousse. There is a note of honey on the long finish.

2006 Pommery Grand Cru £92

Champagne, France

A lovely light yellow colour with an effervescence of tiny and delicate bubbles. Mineral nose surrounded by citrus fruits, followed by mature lemon. Next appear light and delicate scents of spices and white fruits that impart the wine with all its richness. In the mouth, upright and long. Minerality transmits length, fineness and elegance.

2006 Cuvée Dom Pérignon £250

Champagne, France

2006 Cuvée Dom Pérignon hits right away with the softness of its bouquet which is pure and aery, and its bright colour. On the nose, it opens up on a pastel, fruity and floral tone. This evolves into a darker tone with candied and ripe fruits, roasted aromas and liquorice notes. On the palate, the 2006 vintage of Dom Pérignon is silky and complex. This champagne runs and spreads out to its finish in a beautiful and delicious breadth.

2004 Cuvée Sir Winston Churchill Pol Roger £280

Champagne, France

The Champagne is a deep golden-yellow colour with a continuous thread of lingering bubbles. The elegant nose delivers intense and complex aromas, dominated by enticing notes of dried fruit, toasted almond and honey. On the palate the wine is full bodied, boasting a powerful, rich structure, yet well-balanced with a refreshing acidity and flavourful notes of citrus fruit. The finish shows a remarkable length, with creamy notes of butter combined with rich fruitiness of Mirabelle plum and tart, ripe pear.

2004 Pommery Cuvée Louise £195

Champagne, France

Delicately and finely bubbled. Tight and persistent cordon. Clear and bright. Aroma is mature and inviting. Taste is pure and mineral with its attack on the palate. An unexpected vivaciousness for Champagne of this age.

ROSÉ CHAMPAGNE

NV Taittinger Prestige Rosé 125ml Bottle
Champagne, France £78

Fresh aromas of wild strawberries and spice precede the balanced, smooth flavours of red fruits. This Rosé displays charm and a subtle harmony of flavours.

NV Pommery Brut Rosé £15 £88
Champagne, France

Delicate pink with salmon tones in colour and fine bubbles. The nose has small red berries suggesting roundness and softness enhanced by vivacious freshness. A subtle rosé character with a perfectly rounded, long finish.

NV Bollinger Brut Rosé £98
Champagne, France

Bollinger's NV Brut Rosé is a beautiful pink Champagne composed of 62% Pinot Noir, 24% Chardonnay and 14% Pinot Meunier. The wine gets its noble rosé colour from 6% of added red wine from vineyards in Verzenay and A^z. Bread rolls, a hint of mocha and very fine red fruit aromas on the beautifully pure, fresh and perfumed nose lead to a highly delicate and fruity palate with a silky texture and filigreed structure. This is an aromatic, perfectly balanced and intense Rosé of great elegance and finesse. The finish is clear and fresh but also intense and highly stimulating in its subversive salinity.

2004 Cuvée Dom Pérignon Rosé £460
Champagne, France

The Dom Pérignon rosé Vintage 2004 is an exuberant champagne on the nose. It unveils crunchy red berries as redcurrant, blended with warm notes of blood orange and cocoa powder. On the palate, a feeling of precision prevails. The effervescence is revivifying, intense and it gives the wine the possibility to linger on an unexpected note of lime that marks the 2004 vintage. It is a precise and highly nervous vintage by Dom Pérignon.

Blood red with ruby highlights, it has a clear-cut, intense nose with overtones of vanilla, spices, withered roses and underbrush. The palate is dry, but soft, full bodied, velvety and well balanced, and is engagingly complex throughout the lengthy finish.

Quality Pinot Noir from a top domaine in Burgundy. Slightly rustic, meaty and elegant.

A marvellous array of flavours and aromas, especially blackcurrants, wild berries, leather, herbs, chocolate, vanilla, smoky oak and spices. The tannic structure is tight, well integrated and superbly crafted, beginning to soften now and revealing a seductive side to this famous wine.

Pomerol, Bordeaux, France

A heavy-weight of the right bank. Merlot dominant and drinking wonderfully well now.

2005 Sassicaia, Tenuta San Guido £300

Tuscany, Italy

The 2005 Sassicaia is another strong effort from Tenuta San Guido. Medium in body, it reveals an understated, delicate expression of smoke, herbs, tobacco and sweet dark fruit. The wine possesses compelling harmony and a gorgeous sense of inner perfume that flows from start to finish. This is an outstanding showing in a very challenging vintage.

2012 Richebourg Grand Cru, A-F Gros £500

Burgundy, France

This is an unforgettable wine possessing depth and an amazing mix of contrasts: power and finesse. Hints of wild violets, black currant, vanilla and spices that meld into a velvety palate constitute the hallmark of the appellation (power and finesse). Give in to temptation right now.

2007 Chateau Ausone £620

St Emilion, Bordeaux, France

The 2007 Ausone is a candidate for one of the wines of the vintage, rivaling Pavie and Lafite Rothschild. Its deep ruby/purple hue is accompanied by a beautiful nose of spring flowers, raspberries, black currants, and crushed rocks. The wine is dense, medium to full-bodied, and pure with sweet tannin as well as a surprisingly evolved, forward style.

2005 Chateau Margaux £1200

Margaux, Bordeaux, France

One of the best wines of the outstanding 2005 vintage in Bordeaux. The Cabernet was upped to 85% and shows rich plum and purple colours in the glass, just softening around the edges. Attractive, just-starting-to-age claret aromas on the nose – liquorice, black truffles and soft black fruits, all carried through on to the palate, has all of the looked-for elements in play. Great plush texture, lovely balance of acidity, tannins and fruit, love the complexity and it really lingers on the palate.

2017 **Journeymaker Shiraz Cinsault** £26.25

Coastal Region, South Africa

This exciting blend of Shiraz and Cinsaut displays an array of ripe red berries. It follows through with a juicy, well structured palate and a smooth finish.

2014 **The Footbolt Shiraz, d'Arenberg** £45

McLaren Vale, Australia

Another triumph of the Osborne family. Their passion is Rhone varietals and this blend of majority Shiraz with a lick of Viognier and Cabernet produces an outstanding wine. Pepper spice, depth, complexity. One for the arm chair very late at night.

2013 **Milestone Series Syrah, Crossroads** £50

Hawke's Bay, New Zealand

Sourced from the famous Hawke's Bay sub-region of Gimblett Gravels, this complex floral wine, with pepper, cherry, plum, blueberry and smoky aromas has a supple, silky palate with bass notes of sweet fruit, fine tannins, and a long spicy finish.

2015 **Henry's Seven SGV, Henschke** £54

South Australia

A blend of Shiraz, Grenache, Mouvedre and Viognier from the 1st family of Australian wine making. Stephen and Prue Henschke out do themselves year after year. This is a rich textured and full-bodied wine that lifts you up.

2010 **Penfolds Grange** £600

South Australia

Need we say more. The 1st growth of South Australia and from one of the outstanding vintages so far this century according to winemaker Peter Gago.

Seductively silky and smooth, this Pinot Noir ticks all of the right boxes.

2016 Estacion 1833 Cabernet Franc, Trapiche £37.50
Mendoza, Argentina

This Cabernet Franc has aromas of dark fruits such as blueberries and blackcurrants with hints of white pepper. It is smooth on the palate with soft tannins.

2015 Estate Malbec, El Esteco £9.75 £40
Salta, Argentina

A concentrated Malbec with notes of blueberries, dried fruits, raisins, coffee and a touch of herbaceousness. The vibrant palate has firm, juicy tannins and a long length.

2015 Columbia Valley Merlot, Chateau Ste Michelle £10.50 £42
Columbia Valley, Washington State, USA

Elegant Merlot should not come from Eastern Washington State. It is hot, dry and a desert, yet Ch Ste Michelle excel themselves with this silky, smooth, rich and fruit wine.

2013 Cabernet Sauvignon, Long Meadow Ranch £95
Napa Valley, California

100% organic, the family not only grow wine but they have a huge organic farm in the centre of Napa Valley. Their whole ethos is centred around respect for the place which has help to create a truly beautiful complex Cabernet that will age for years.

2005 Pax, Agharta Syrah £180
Sonoma, California, USA

Opaque ruby. Black and blue fruit aromas are complemented by exotic notes of anise, incense and black cardamom. Fleshy but nicely focused black and blue fruit flavors gain sweetness with air and pick up notes of succulent herbs and candied flowers.
